There were many projects in EGAT and Khun Lek Kanchanaphol was always most helpful

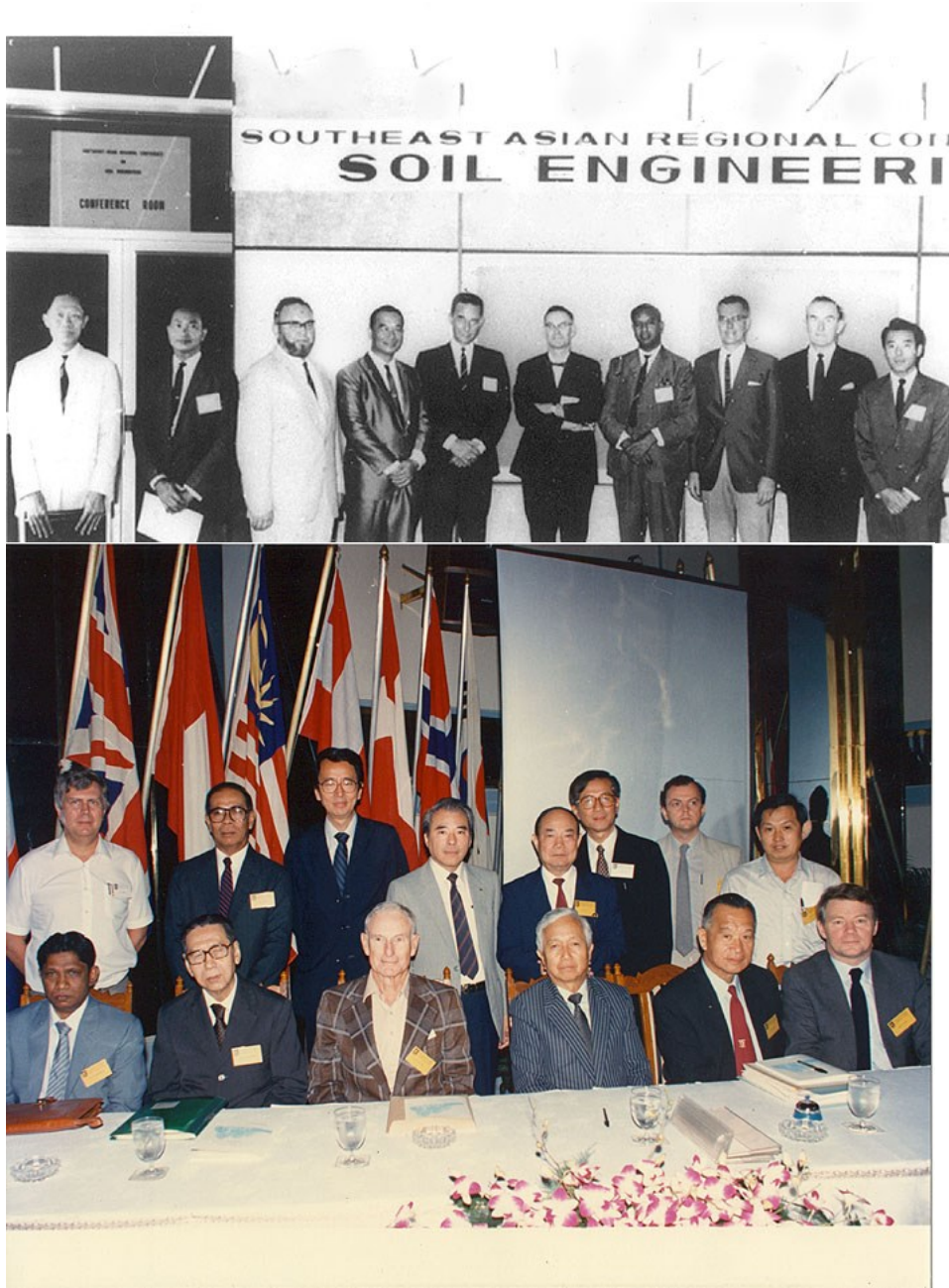


It is impossible to cover all our AIT Alumni, my album contains Dr. Premchit. Famous Dennes, Dr. Yongyuth and many others
