#### **Summary:**

- 1: Additionally, in this report, first the journal Issues since KL Conference in May 2016 when our regular SEAGS was held is presented. For these Issues, the number of papers and page numbers are virtually complete.

- 3: Now we have Journal Issues on contributed papers more or less one Issue per year. Most Guest Editors are from SEAGS-AGSSEA member countries; indeed they are doing excellent job. Occasionally we have editors from Japan, India and Australia.
- 4: We are continuously trying to improve the journal circulation and exploring the merits of a commercial publisher for many years now. Prof Chu Jian is studying this part. Hope all of you can help him: I tried hard to increase the subscribers and must say did not succeed. We like to have a commercial publisher who is flexible and allow us to proceed with minimum disturbance solely with the aim to increase the circulation. We collect membership fees and subscription fees and also have Life Members. Also, the journal income goes into SEAGS funds for all our activities. The financial funding annually from the commercial publisher must work out better than what we now achieve. We must maintain as much as possible healthy reserve funds. The Reserve funds have continuously increased from the membership fees, journal subscriptions and donations. Please see Table below:
