The Malaysian Geotechnical Society (MGS) was incorporated on March 14, 2013. The objective of the society is to promote the theory and good practice of geotechnical engineering and to foster the involvement of its members in national as well as international geotechnical activities. Ir Dr Ting Wen Hui is the Founder Chairman with Ir Yee Yew Weng as General Secretary and Ir Dr Chan Sin Fatt as Deputy Chairman.

The inaugural meeting of MGS was held on June 6, 2013 at the Tan Sri. Prof. Chin Fung Kee Auditorium, Wisma IEM, Petaling Jaya. Membership is opened to all those registered Professional Engineers in The Board of Engineers, Malaysia (PEng BEM), and Members of The Institution of Engineers, Malaysia (MIEM) who are interested and practising in the field of geotechnical engineering in Malaysia. MGS also admits others who are interested in geotechnical engineering as Associate members. At present, MGS has 71 members consisting of 51 Members (MMGS) and 20 Associate Members (AMMGS).


