Mr Thanin Bumrungsap graduated with Bachelor's degree in civil engineering from Khon Kaen University in Thailand in 1969 and Master's degree in Geotechnical Engineering from the AIT in 1972, the last class of graduates when AIT was at the old campus in Chulalongkorn University before moving to the present premises. He worked for a few years at the

AIT as a Geotechnical Engineering research lab supervisor and was involved in the full scale test sections as part of subsoils investigation of the site of the new Bangkok International Airport at Nong Ngoo Hao before the project was suspended in 1973. (The airport project has been revived and construction is being completed now.) He joined Italian-Thai Development Plc, Thailand's largest construction firm, in 1975, and has been involved, directly and indirectly, in construction of highways, two large hydroelectric dams (Bang Lang Dam and Khao Laem Dam – now officially named Vajiralongkorn Dam), and the present international terminal of the Bangkok International Airport at Donmuang.

Lately he has been fully involved in development of the welknown Nam Theun 2 Hydroelectric project in Lao PDR.

His present position is Vice President of Italian-Thai Development Plc. His latest technical paper (as a co-author) is "Nam Theun 2 Hydroelectric Project and Community Development" which he presented to the 11 National Convention on Civil Engineering in Phuket, Thailand, in April 2006.
